Here at Southern Peaks Regional Treatment Center we understand and value the importance of each youth having their own belongings and so we are asking that the attached list of clothing be provided with the youth, upon admission (or as soon as possible) into Southern Peaks Regional Treatment Center. These changes will be in effect as of June 1, 2013.

Southern Peaks Regional Treatment Center will furnish you with laundry detergent and basic toiletry items such as soap, toothpaste and deodorant.

Required items include:

- 8 sets of day time clothing
  - 4 pairs of jeans
  - 2 pairs of pants
  - 2 pairs of shorts
  - 4 t-shirts
  - 2 polo shirts
  - 2 long sleeve shirts
  - 8 pairs of socks
  - 8 pair of underwear (no thong underwear)
  - 6 bras with no underwire (for female youth)
  - 1 winter hat
  - 1 pair gloves
- 1 pair of shower shoes
- 1 winter jacket
- 1 light jacket or sweatshirt
- 2 sets of night time clothing
  - 3 pj sets (should be two piece and cover chest, collar bones, and shoulders)
  - 1 pair of slippers
- 1 rec outfit
  - 2 pairs of athletic shorts
  - 2 pairs of athletic pants or sweat pants
  - 2 t-shirts
  - 1 pair of athletic tennis shoes

Expectations:

- Clothing cannot be torn
- Clothing must fit appropriately:
  - The waistline on pants cannot sag or hang below the waistline
  - All clothing should not fit too tight or expose bare skin on the midriff, shoulders, back, buttocks, or chest
- Clothing must be free of numbers, large writing, and logos of any kind
- Stripes, patterns, and plaid colors are permitted as long as they are not representing gang activity.
- Approved solid colors are:
  - White
  - Gray
  - Silver
  - Green
  - Brown / Tan
  - Pink
  - Yellow
- Blue jeans are acceptable
- Pants have to be tan or Khaki
- No solid red or blue shoes
- No A shirts or tank tops: all shirts must cover shoulders and collar bones.
- Hats have to be plain color white, black or grey and have to be free from logos
- Any clothing that staff feels is being worn or is representing the youth inappropriately may be confiscated at any time.

**A comprehensive list is almost impossible to put together, ultimately it is the discretion of staff members to determine if something is appropriate or not. If something is deemed inappropriate, it will be confiscated and placed in personals.**
