## Safe Return to School Plan

### Plan for Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services

#### Important Dates

\*This plan will be reviewed every 6 months

- \*We are a residential facility. We will continue to provide in-person learning support, depended on Covid status
- 1<sup>st</sup> review before 5/20 when LEA use of funds due
- 2<sup>nd</sup> review before 9/2

#### In-Person and/or Remote Options

- Our school is in person 5 days per week
- When on quarantine status, students may attend remotely

#### Social, Emotional, Mental, and other Needs

- Therapists will provide in person services
- When youth are on quarantine status, therapists will provide remote services
- Meals are provided directly to student's location

### Layered Prevention Strategies

#### CDC Recommendations

- Promoting Vaccination – strongly encouraging vaccination
- Consistent and Correct Mask Use – masks are required for all staff; N95 masks are required for Covid positive units
- Physical Distancing – youth from different housing units are not cross programming
- Screening/Testing – twice weekly for all staff; weekly for all youth;
- Handwashing and Respiratory Etiquette – instructions, training, attestations, enforcement of hand washing protocols
- Staying Home when Sick/Getting Tested – staff are encouraged to stay home if sick; daily screenings occur prior to entering the facility; any staff who do not pass screening take rapid tests or go home until symptoms subside
